

Final Report of the Joint Bilateral Agreement CNR/CINVESTAV (Mexico)

Biennial Programme 2019-2020

Considering the Joint Bilateral Agreement signed on November 9, 2015, the joint call for the bilateral project program launched on March 21, 2018 and a recent exchange of emails between CINVESTAV (Mexico) and CNR, both Parties have jointly decided to fund, within the framework of the future joint program, up to 2 projects granting 25.000 Euros per year for 2 years.

At the deadline fixed by the call, 22 proposals have been submitted to both Parties.

After the evaluation procedures performed independently by both Parties, the assessed projects of each research area obtaining the highest scores, have been taken into account.


Despite the large number of good proposals received, the Parties agreed to finance the following proposals included in a final ranking list:


