You have to indicate: NATIONALITY / COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE / LENGTH OF STAY UP TO 90 DAYS / BUSINESS

Requirements of the **BUSINESS VISA** for non-Mexican citizens residents in Mexico or Belizean citizens.
THE APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED MAXIMUM 180 DAYS AND MINIMUM 15 DAYS BEFORE THE VISIT

SCHENGEN VISA

The following documents are needed:

- 1) Visa form type C
- 2) One recent color photo, passport size
- 3) Copy of residence permit (FM immigration permit) - Not for Belizean citizens
- 4) Passport with validity of at least three months from expiry of your required visa (and copy of the page with photo)
- 5) Roundtrip airplane flight reservation
- 6) Proof of the accommodation in Italy with: copy of your leasing contract; hotel/Airbnb reservation; "Dichiarazione di Ospitalità"

- 7) Situation of the applicant:
 - A) letter from the firm in which you are working that details salary, position and seniority (or the funding act of your own enterprise and an accountant's statement detailing salary, position and seniority with copy of the professional license and "CONSTANCIA DE SITUACION FISCAL SAT")
 - B) pay stubs of the last three months
 - C) banking statements of the last three months (see the attached table of the minimum financial requirements for entering Italy

- 8) documentation issued by the relevant local authorities proving the actual position of economic-commercial operator (e.g. : operating licence, company registration certificate , etc.)
- 9) schedule of the stay with the business contacts and the contact details in Italy, or letter of invitation from the Italian company <https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/Moduli/it/LetteradiinvitoperAFFARI.pdf>
- 10) Copy of insurance with a minimal coverage of € 30,000 for urgent hospitalization and repatriation with explicit reference to the Schengen area or to European countries.

The applicant has to come personally to this Office to take the finger prints.

In case the applicant's finger prints have already been taken by Italy or another U.E. country in the last 59 months, he/she has to submit or send a copy of the issued visa.

We can try to collect from the system your fingerprints.

If it is not possible to take your fingerprints from the system, you have to schedule an appointment writing to visti.messico@esteri.it in order to be received by this Office.

THE EMBASSY MAY REQUEST ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION

THE DOCUMENTATION DOESN'T GUARANTEE THE VISA WHICH DEPENDS ON THE EVALUATION OF THE EMBASSY AND THE AUTHORIZATIONS FROM ITALY/E.U. COUNTRIES.

You will be asked to present one original and one photocopy of the required documents.

- ***The cost of the visa is 60 euros. You have to pay in cash and in Mexican pesos at the moment of submitting the application.***
